Administration Report: Mrs. Eadie-Gyori & Mrs. Dawn Normoyle

  - 95% of students to be reading at grade level; Last year we were 95.3%
  - 85% writing at grade level Chinook edge focus is grades 4-9/10
    - Mipi report to help parents and teachers know how well the school is doing
    - Our school French report met expectations at 100% of students above the 50% grade; Full school report to be shared at next meeting (insufficient data)
